Family Child Care providers are caring, thoughtful, military spouses who have gone through extensive background checks, training, and inspections.

Providers are selected on a non discriminatory basis. Children and providers with chronic health problems or special needs are encouraged to become part of the FCC program.

All providers are trained in:

- First Aid/CPR
- Child Development
- Health/Safety
- Recognizing Child Abuse/Neglect

Homes are comfortable, relaxed, and Happy!

They are friendly, warm, nurturing, compassionate, full of understanding, and lots of love.

Subsidy is available, depending on Total Family Income (TFI). Providers have access to the FCC Resource Center for safety items, cribs, cots, toys, games, outdoor equipment, and general supplies. Having these resources available to providers greatly assists providers and eliminates the need for higher fees.
